

SUMMARY TO ACCOMPANY SHORELINE MAP HANDSCHIPTS T-10858 Through T-10869

The twelve (12) subject surveys, extending from MILLER ISLAND eastward to the term of ARLINOTON, Oregon are part of project Ph-5807. The entire project consists of forty-nine (49) shoreline surveys which cover the Columbia River and adjacent land areas of Oregon and Washington from Bonneville eastward to Umatilla. It was designed to aid in the construction of a new series of nautical charts.

A steresplanigraph bridging plot of the twelve subject surveys was done in the Mashington Office in May 1959 (see separate report). They were compiled by Kelsh stereoscopic instruments in the Perbland Thotogrammetric Office during the latter part of 1959 from photography of August 1958 and field inspection information (whereline, Nersh-appl) 1959; interior, July-August 1959).

The completed compilations as submitted to the Washington Office are the result of adequately saribed sheets and suitable for the direct reproduction of registration capies.

A srenar film positive at the compilation scale of 1:20,000 and the Descriptive Report of each will be registered and filed in the Eureau Archives.
