

TOPOGRAPHIC SHEETS OF PORT MADISON

The wharf at Point Monroe and the two wharves in Apple Tree Cove are shown on the attached sheet. The shore line was rerun by traverse.

The projection on the field sheet is to be neglected as the sheet was furnished for another purpose but the bad weather made it imperative to use this heavy paper and not the detail paper that I had been using on the other work.

The small wharves in Apple Tree Cove are all in bad shape and will probably be removed before very long. The two wharves at Kingston and Newe&lhurst are comparitively new.
