Description of Topographic Sheet No. 2

This work was done in two days by the usual plane table methods on a blank sheet - no projection was put on in the field, and the work was not inked, ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~

Station Eliza was recovered and run in, and a line of Orientation determined to Station Francis. This line between these two triangulation stations is on the sheet, and should be used in fitting on the projection.

All the area covered is on Eliza Island, Bellingham Bay, and the improvements shown are the property of the Pacific American Fisheries Co.

All the shore line adjacent to the improvements is sandy - in the vicinity of Sta Eliza it is rocky.

The scale is 1: 5000.

The time available for working on this sheet was very limited; all the buildings were run in, and the wharfs and Marine Ways, but not the racks for drying nets. These latter cover a large cleared area, but are not very permanent.
