

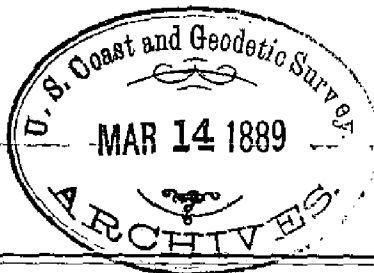

length & is a continuation of the topography of the
sheet entitled Right Bank of St. Croix River Me
from Devil's Head to Mill Cove

What has been written in my report for this latter
sheet applies in the main to the sheet entitled
Right Bank of St. Croix River Me. from Mill
Cove to Lewis Cove

This latter sheet has in it 2 Post Offices which
serve to small villages called So. Robinson at
the head of Mill Cove & N. Perry at the head
of Lewis Cove these villages & a Sanderson factory
on Lewis Cove are the only features of all worth
of note
