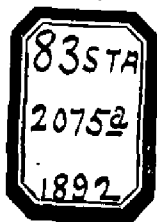

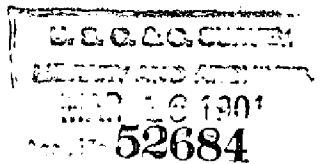

This was a so-called "experimental survey", the same area which had already been surveyed on 1:4800, being successively delineated on the three scales of 1:20000, 1:30000 and 1:40000 by three different officers. This is that on 1:20000.

The general character of the country is rolling, with numerous patches of woodland.

There is a good deal of artificial detail, including county roads, rail road, and a suburban subdivision.

There is very little arable land and grassland and woodland are in about equal parts.

The Baltimore and Ohio railroad crosses this square mile and "Langdon" station is nearly in its centre.
