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Descriptive report of Original
Topographic Sheet No. 2088
from Little Lagoon to Ala-
Pana Point.

Sheet No. 2088 begins a little East of the entrance of Little Lagoon and includes Cotton Δ a little West of the entrance of Perdido Bay. The Survey was made by measuring offsets from the line of the Beach measurement. Little Lagoon is a small inlet which is not navigable, and it can be forded at low tide. West of the inlet there are broken sand bars varying from 10 to 20 feet in height.

The ridge is covered with a dense ^{scrub} growth, in places, diminishing as we go East. The country covered by this Survey is not arable nor is it adapted to grazing.

The changes in the coast line except in the vicinity of inlets is probably slight as the beach is protected by a submerged ridge lying a little off shore.

No roads or other improvements are mapped in the Survey. Fairly good water can be obtained near the beach by digging a shallow well -
