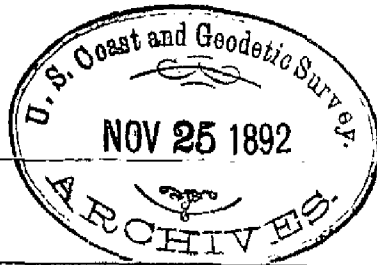
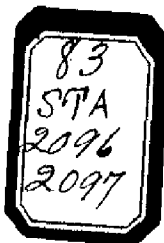

On sheets Nos. 1 & 2 of the Topogr. Survey
S.E. of Plymouth Mass. and W. of Cape Cod
Bay, on the scale of 1:30000 are given: all
the roads, ponds, cranberry bogs, brooks, creeks,
houses, prominent barns and wood outlines
within the area of 25 sq. miles embraced by
this survey.

The main roads are represented in full
heavy lines.

Secondary roads are represented in faint
full lines, and

Half grown up woodroads in broken lines.

All elevations were determined with vertical
circle of alidade. The contours are given in
twenty feet vertical intervals and the mean

Sea Level was selected as the datum plane for all hypsometrical data. The topography is sketched and controlled by p. t. traverse lines along the roads.
