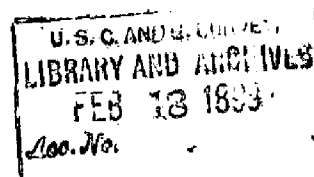

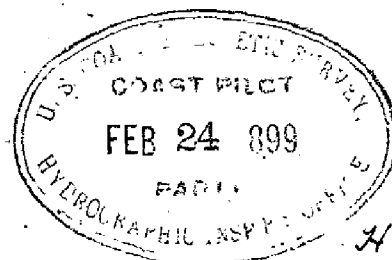

Kwemeluk Channel, Yukon River. Descriptive Report.

This small piece of topography, executed on September 9th. 1898, by Assistant G. R. Putnam with a plane-table, joins on to the Kusilvek Entrance Sheet.

The characteristics of the Kwemeluk have been given in the reports on the Kusilvak Entrance Sheet and the Yukon Delta Reconnaissance.

The soundings shown, on the tracing, have also been added to the Kusilvak Entrance Hydrographic Sheet.

The dotted portion of the shore line is sketched from tangents. There are a few Eskimo huts at Eleutakamāūt, unoccupied on Sept'r. 9th.

The little stream Elutak, is said to head, a short distance back, in a large lake.
