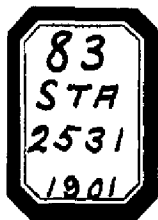

Topographic Sheet No. 2531

This sheet extends from Punta Arco Gorda to the Rio Manati joining sheet No. 2530 on the east and No. 2532 on the west.

The coast line of this sheet is sand beach with occasional stretches of rocky bluffs of coral formation - The same line of breakers is noted off the shore as on sheet No. 2530 - which has an easterly to the west direction. Landing on any portion of this coast is hazardous on account of the heavy swell and breakers.

The most important feature near the coast is "Lake Totuquero", the outline of which was determined during the dry season - The size of this lake may be greatly increased during the rainy season.

Sugar and tobacco are the principal crops of the coast land.

The roads shown on this sheet are of the same character as those described on sheet No. 2530.
