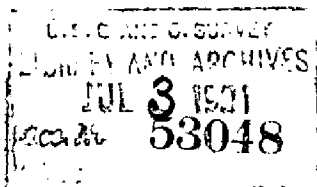

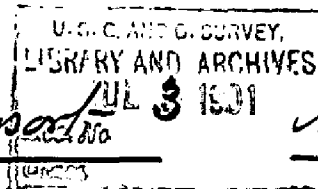

Descriptive Report May 1901.

The Cordillera Reef extends from Cape San Juan Head eastward about 12 miles with two passages near its eastern end the Hermanos and Garriles Passages. The topography from Cape San Juan Head to Lobo Cay was done last year and will be found on the sheet of Fajardo Harbor. The Δ in depends on the Culbra Base & Battle Cay & St. Thomas Astro's data. A heavy sea breaks over these cays & rocks almost constantly making landing on them at all times difficult & dangerous & often impossible.

The topography was executed in January 1901 by Mr. F. F. Weld, Asst. C. & G. S. Quinting lines were observed from Palominas station on all of these rocks and Mr. Weld succeeded in landing on most of them and determining his position from the stations on Cactus Cay, Lobo Cay, & Diablo Cay.
