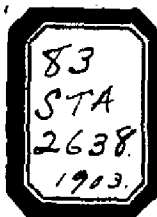

The geological features of the country depicted is as usual, molded
drift. The relief does not exceed 50 ft until the water shed of the Potomac
key Creek passes into those of the River and Piscataway Creek. In the upper
quarter the relief rises to the highest recorded in sheet No. 1. No distinctive
rock formation exists. Rock marl appears infrequently in the cliffs that
touch the River shore.

The conditions noted in the report for Sheet No. 1 are found in the
area herein described which extends from Potomac Creek to Piscataway Creek
and Fort Washington.
