


The geologic Flighteature of the country depicted is as usual molded REFERRED: drift .The Argel temples; not exceed 50 ft until the water shed of the Pomon-key Creek passes into those of the River and Piscatawav Creek. In the upper quarter the relief rises to the highest recorded in sheet No.1. No distinctive rock formation exists. Book marl appears infrequently in the cliffs that touch the River shore.

The conditions noted in the report for Sheet No.1 are found in the area herein described which extends from Pomonkey Creek to Piscataway Creek and Fort Washington.
