Surveyed in 1907 and 1908

by the party on the Steamer Patterson,

W. C. Hodgkins, Commanding.

With regard to this place, there is little that I can add to my previous reports submitted with other sheets. The trade facilities remain as before. The price of coal delivered on board ship at the wharf is \$14 per ton in 1908.

The Steamer Portland, belonging to the Alaska Coast Company, makes one trip each month from Seattle, leaving that port on the tenth day of the month, when on time.

The Steamer Dora, which makes a monthly trip from Seward to Unalaska, touching at Kodiak both going and returning, is now the property of the "Alaska Steamship Company of Nevada", a new corporation resulting from the consolidation of the old Alaska Steamship Company and the Northwestern Steamship Company.

This survey was begun last year for the purpose of furnishing the shore line of the harbor on a scale large enough to permit of platting close soundings.

In the spring of the present year, during the absence of the Patterson at Dutch Harbor the topography in and around the village was added to the map for the sake of completeness.

The Department of Agriculture has now at Kodiak for experimental purposes a small herd of cattle. Some buildings are being erected and it is understood that the principal breeding station will be established in Kalsin Bay, but maintaining a station at Kodiak also.

I probably mentioned in a previous report that there are at Kodiak a government school and a Russian church, to which is attached a mission school for native orphans.


