

Descriptive Report

to accompany Topographic Sheet No

Kupreanof Strait, Alaska,

from Dry Spruce Island to Malina Point.

Surveyed in 1907 and 1908

by the party on the Steamer Patterson,

W. C. Hodgkins, Commanding.

The area included on this sheet is almost entirely undeveloped, the only inhabitants being two men who have a "fox ranch" on Bare Island in Dry Spruce Bay.

The northern or Raspherry Island shore is mountainous and has only some small scattered clumps of trees, the mountains being generally grass covered.

The shore of the Kupreanof Peninsula, on the southern side of the strait is not so uniformly mountainous, though Kupreanof Mountain which rises from the shore of Dry Spruce Bay to a height of 2400 feet is more precipitous and rocky than any other part of the shores of the strait.

The mountains to the westward of this one are lower and of easier slope. They are covered with grass and occasional scattering spruce trees.

The greater part of Kupreanof Mountain is a mass of bare, gray rock with a very rough and broken surface making it a striking land mark which may be seen for many miles either east or west.

Dry Spruce Island and the shore to the east are covered with a dense growth of spruce trees.

There is no agricultural development in this district and the only business carried on is the small item of a few fox skins annually from the ranch on Bare Island.

There are no roads, bridges, or other works of men and all communication is by water.


