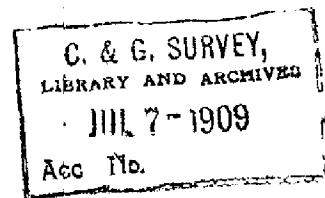

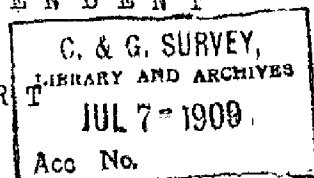

NORTH CAROLINA: CROATAN SOUND FROM  
ROANOKE MARSHES TO REDSTONE POINT  
June 10--16, 1909.

Re-survey of the shore line of western side of  
Croatan Sound, N. C.

A projection was made, (scale 1--20,000) and the stations  
Roanoke Marshes L. H., Croatan L. H., and Blockade Shoal Beacon  
plotted from geographic positions furnished by the Office.

From these, the remaining stations were plotted from  
the triangle sides from the field computation of Assistant  
J. W. Maupin.

The small village shown on Roanoke Marshes is com-  
posed of small houses occupied by fishermen during the fishing  
season.
