Descriptive Report for sheet around Homer Shore Line.

The shore line on the south side of the sheet is rocky little beyond © Pat, and from there to the eastward, there is a small sand spit, on which © Mat and © pip are located. Behind this spit there is the low swamp, formed by the outlet of a glacier, which bares at low water, with the exception of numerous small streams, which carry the glacier-water to the sea. Owing to lack of time, the shore-line along this swamp was not located. The entrance to the swamp comes between the sand-spit and © ^{Pis,} ~~Pip~~ which is on a rocky bluff on the main shore. At the head of Homer Spit, is a marsh, which covers at high water. The topography was carried a little below Δ Coal, and up to the Gull Islands, with the exception noted above.
