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

The resurvey of this part of the coast line was done in connection with the offshore hydrographic survey for the purpose of detecting the changes which may have occurred since the previous surveys of the locality, as it was plainly evident that considerable changes had taken place in some parts of this shore.

On account of the paucity of determined positions and also in a measure on account of unfavorable weather conditions, the survey was made by running compass traverses with the planetable and then adjusting the results to fit the known points.

No points suitable for use in future surveys were determined in the course of this work and the customary table is therefore omitted.
