The only town on this sheet is Weeksville, three and a half miles up Newbegin creek, where there are two stores, a post office, saw mill and cotton gin.

SHORES
- - - - -

The shores are low, mostly of a poquoson character, but on the western side and up the river, ^{are} higher stretches rising to a height of four to six feet, above mean water.

SURFACE
- - - - -

The surface is quite flat, slightly undulating and cut up largely by poquoson swamps.

WATER
- - - - -

The water of the river is fresh and naturally of a good quality. Water is found ^{most} in places by driving a well to a depth of eight or ten feet.

OCCUPATION
- - - - -

The principal occupation is farming, fishing is also carried on.

PRODUCTS.
- - - - -

The products are those of general farming, some fish are shipped, and lumber is constantly being shipped but at only about the rate that it grows.
