Descriptive Report to Accompany Topographic Sheet  
of Egg Bank.

The work was done by the party from the Launch MIKAWA, R.F.Luce, Chief of Party, under instructions of the Director, Coast and Geodetic Survey, dated February 18, 1921.

Methods: The mapping of Egg Bank was done by planetable, location being obtained by occupation of a topographic station previously established and orientation by a cut on triangulation station Ott. The beacons were cut in by planetable.

Landmarks: There are no landmarks, the shoal being mainly sand with a small area of grass on the N northern island of the two islands which compose the shoal.
