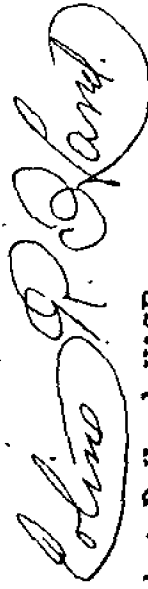

DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

to accompany topographic sheet "A", Barber's Point to sta. KAHE, southwest Oahu, T. H
Eoline R. Hand, Chief of Party.

This topographic survey (and the coexistent hydrographic survey of the same limits) was executed at the request of the War Department. The considerations that govern the character of the survey are as expressed and outlined in Hawaiian Department letter of January 28, 1924 (Engr. 600.93) a copy of which is I believe in the confidential files of this Office. In addition it was verbally indicated to me that nothing was desired beyond and inside of the shoreline itself, so what little that is shown is purely gratuitous, it might be said, and designed to offer a convenient tie for other surveys past or future.

No information on the terrain is stated beyond what I have incorporated in the sheet itself. I shall however amplify my landing notes in the report of the complementary hydrographic sheet No. 1.
