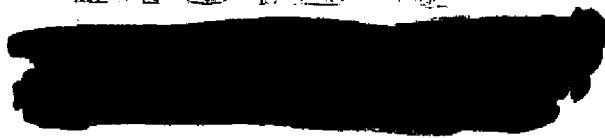

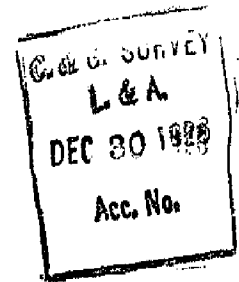
1. The records conform to the requirements of the General Instructions.
