T-4269 was a reconnaissance survey made in 1927 on scale 1:20,000. As there was no triangulation existing at the time, the control was inadequate for the location of the detached islets and shoals.

The area was resurveyed on T-4367b in 1928 on scale 1:10,000. Triangulation was extended over the entire group of islets which gave excellent control, and the survey is in accordance with standard practice. As this survey is more complete and accurate than T-4269 the latter, on recommendation of the Chief of Chart Division, was cancelled on February 11, 1936 and has been destroyed.
