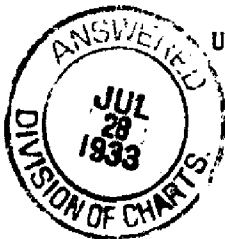

Subject: Additions to Chart 8537.

A tracing is being forwarded under separate cover showing form lines in vicinity of Cape Trinity, Alitak Bay, Kodiak Island, Alaska.

The form lines were located by plane table and all elevations indicated were checked from three stations.

It is believed that the accuracy of the elevations and the form lines is comparable to usual plane table work.

All other parts of the chart show form lines and their omission in this area give an erroneous impression of the character of the country which deceived me when approaching the cape. It is therefore recommended that these form lines be added to the chart when additions are made from recent surveys.

It is suggested that this tracing may be filed as an "A" sheet with the topographic sheet covering this area.
