AUTHORITY:

Instructions from the Director dated November 17, 1933 (H.A.Cotton).

LIMITS:

The ocean shore of Key Largo from Pt. Elizabeth to Latitude 25 - 09, including Garden Cove.

CONTROL:

There is ample control on this sheet consisting of (13) triangulation stations well distributed over the entire sheet.

METHODS & CLOSURES:

Methods:

An aluminum sheet and the usual planetable methods of traverse were used. The traverse was checked by frequent re-sections from the offshore stations.

DESCRIPTION OF COAST:

GENERAL:

Key Largo is a low lying coral key thickly covered with scrub and bordered on the ocean shore by a fringe of mangrove. The shoreline is rock. The section of the key within the limits of the sheet is sparsely inhabited and has little commercial value. Some lime groves have been established and there are a few winter fishing camps in the vicinity of Garden Cove. South of Garden Cove the Florida East Coast Railroad and Overseas Highway parallel each other along the center of the key.

GARDEN COVE:

During the "Florida Boom" a sub division known as Key Largo City was laid out at Garden Cove. The development collapsed and at the present time this sub division is thickly covered with scrub mangrove. During the winter months the cove is used somewhat by pleasure fishing boats.
