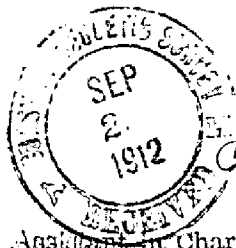

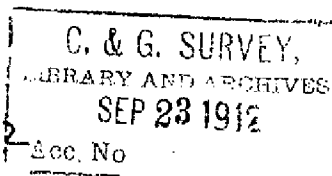

This sheet was revised in September 1912.

The shore line is unchanged. The islands are covered with vines and grass, there are no trees.

The population during winter is small, a few fishermen and care takers for the hotels. During summer there is quite a good patronage of the two hotels. A steamer, during the season, makes two or more round trips daily.

A cable connects, by telephone, with the main land. The stone fences shown on the old sheet have disappeared or are in such poor repair as to leave doubt as to their position, hence they are either marked as not being in existence or not shown on the new sheet.
