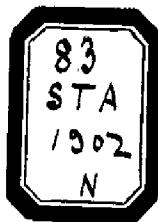

Topographic Sheet No. 2582 -

This sheet adjoins No. 2581 at Pt. Vacia Telegas and extends to Pt. Entarcedero - The shore line is a sand beach throughout with the exception of a small portion in the vicinity of Pt. Telegas where there is a rocky bluff from 40 to 60 ft. high - Loiza is a small town at the mouth of the Rio Grande de Loiza - It is composed principally of native shacks - There are large groves of coconuts trees in this vicinity extending to the Rio Grande the latter a small stream emptying into the ocean near Pt. Miguelito - This river is navigable for small craft as far as the town of Rio Grande, a distance of about three miles - The Memelle River is a small stream shown on the eastern edge of the sheet. It has no outlet to the sea, its mouth being closed by large sand dunes - A military road extends from the town of Rio Grande to the town of Memelle -
