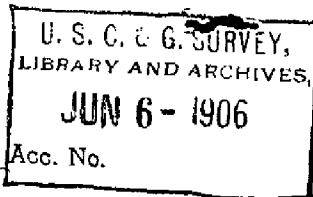

The Country from Saint Clement Bay to Piney Point along the River Shore is low and flat rising to an elevation of 120 feet above Mean High Water on the Potomac one mile back from the shore,

The Country Surveyed is partly timbered interspersed with fine farms under a high state of Cultivation. There are good Wharves on Saint Clement and Breton's Bay, and at Piney Point; where the Baltimore Steam Packet makes landings three times a week to and from Washington and Baltimore,

The County roads leading to the County Seat, Leonardtown, are in good condition during the Summer and Autumn months,
