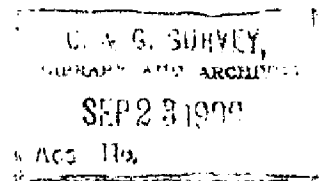

This sheet was surveyed during July and August 1909 in compliance with instructions dated May 10th, 1909.

The sheet is not a complete topographic survey of the region shown, but a survey to determine the position of the shore line and of objects etc., useful to the navigator and surveyor. The shore line along the entire Ocean beach was resurveyed, and other points tested and rerun when a change from the former survey was noted. The houses at Nassau by the sea, and in the vicinity of Point Lookout Life Saving Station with a few club and apartment houses are the only structures within the area, and are practically all the improvements made since the previous survey of this region. A ferry operates on a hourly schedule, between Freeport and Nassau by the sea, with two trips to Wreck Beach, each day. A list of plausible positions and of objects of probable use to navigation is herewith submitted.
