The entire area is marshy and covered with grass and canes from four to ten ft. high. The shoreline shown is the edge of vegetation which is often in a foot of water. Almost the whole is soft mud.

This mud and the shallow water outside the grass make plane table work difficult.

Outside the lighthouses located by triangulation the post lights along the river and the houses at Port Eads and Pilot Town there are no permanent marks.
