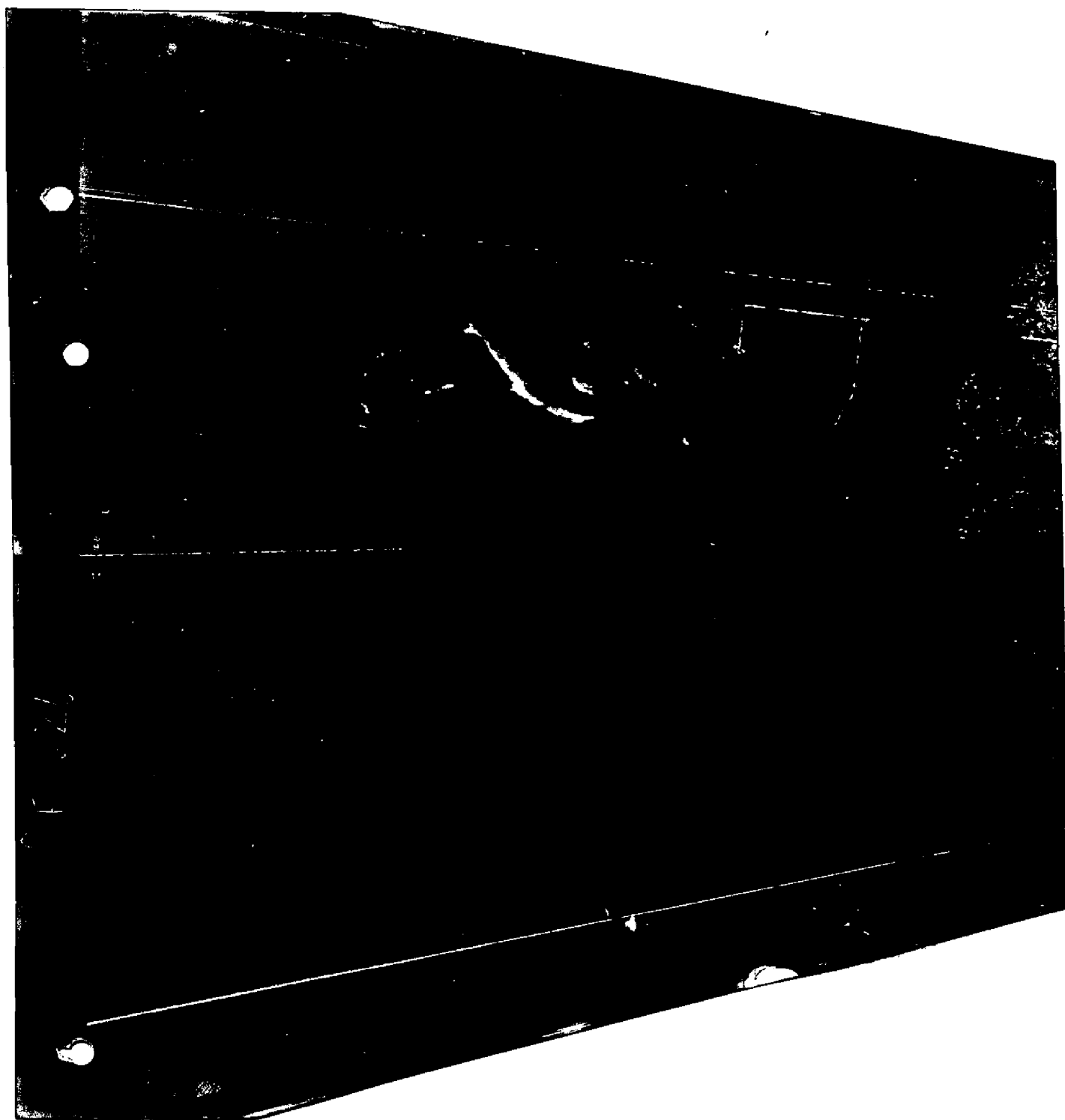

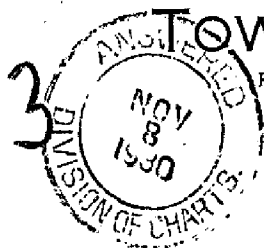

Gentlemen,

In reply to your letter 10/27/30 #3VEC,
 I enclose P.O. Money Order for 50¢ being balance
 due on sheets #4458a & 4542.

In regard to #4458a. will say that I appreciate
 that detail is unimportant in areas remote from the
 coast, yet I suggest that you correct the river in
 the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20 T.40s R.42e, as I antic-
 ipate this sheet will be used extensively by winter
 tourist fishermen who have a camp at this point for
 rest and lunch and the error is so obvious that it
 will throw discredit on the whole map.

The enclosed print , which please return, is
 made by pacing the distances from known points on
 the land survey and then corrected up by boat from
 the river, it is a thick jungle of vines but the
 result is approximately correct, and I know it is
 correct at the camp in question.

From my knowledge of the topography in this
 area there is something that should be checked at
 Lat., 26-59'30" Long. 80-09'-30" where there is an
 arm shooting out into a high pine & palmetto land
 without the usual swamp shown, I am not familiar
 with the river at this point except that "Kitching
 Creek" flows in from the north.
