## DESCRIPTIVE REPORT TO ACCOMPANY

## TOPOGRAPHIC SHEET - SOUTH FARALLON ISLANDS

Instructions Dated - May 24, 1932

U. S. C. & G. S. S. PIONEER

The Lighthouse is the most prominent landmark, being on the LANDMARKS: highest part of the eastern end of the island. South of the lighthouse there are many buildings, the most prominent one being the one with the brick chimney.

CONTROL: The azimuth was carried from the line Farallon L. H. and Farallon Island Radio Tower ( E. Base )

The table was set up CLOSING ERRORS OF TRAVERSES RUN AND HOW ADJUSTED: at the Radio Tower and oriented on the Lighthouse. Traverse was run from this setup around to the north landing via the railroad track and back across the saddle via the trail and closed on the second setup away from the initial. This closed without error in either azimuth er distance. The lighthouse was re-sected on at all of the setups as a check on the orientation and distance.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS SURVEYS: Many new buildings have been constructed since the old survey ( sheet no. 1259 ). No changes in shoreline were noted. As a check on the new survey, the shoreline around the north and east landings was rodded in and shown in ink on this sheet. The Radio Compass Station has been moved. The building housing the old station at " Radio Compass Station 1921" was burned several years ago and a new building constructed at the location shown on the sheet as R.C. This location is the result of three cuts to the pelorus stand over the loop antenna, and was checked by the rod redings to locate three corners of the building.

REMARKS: The saddle rock ( eastern knob ), south of the island, was transferred to the sheet and cuts taken. The highest part of the western part of the island was transferred and cuts taken. There was a pole on this peak and cuts were to the pole. These cuts are left on the sheet in pencil.

The red circles are locations of points and objects that may be used as control for subsequent surveys. The names describe the objects and points. The cylindrical tanks are shown as circles and cross-hatched. The dome-shaped cisterns are shown by circles without cross-hatching. These cisterns are white and show up very well from the air. The Navy personnel live at the meridian 123 00 and east while the Lighthouse personnel live in the westerly settlement. Clifton J. Wagner
